The Seaport is actively seeking business and community sponsors to allow this service to continue free of charge to guests.

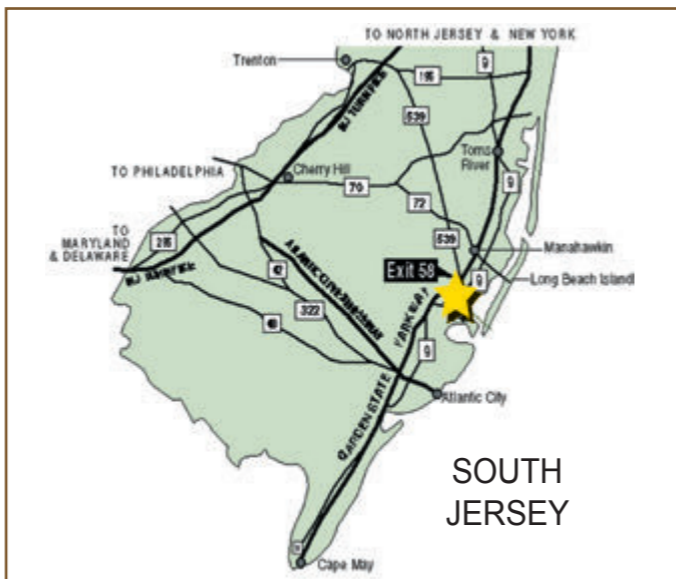

2pm: Departing from Tuckerton Seaport
(This will be the last return trip to Beach Haven for the day)
3:30pm: Departing from Beach Haven
(This will be the last return trip to Tuckerton for the day)

The trip across the bay takes approximately one leisurely, scenic hour and includes an eco-tour while in transit. The water ferry service is currently free of charge.

All guests must bring a PRINTED copy of their boarding pass for their reserved seats. All guests must be boarded 15 minutes prior to sailing, after that time all reserved seats will be released. Exceptions cannot be made.

The Tuckerton Seaport/Beach Haven Water Ferry is a 30' pontoon boat and is wheelchair accessible. The boat does have a canopy to protect guests from the elements. Safety always comes first. All guests are required to wear life vests which will be provided in both adult and child sizes. The pontoon boat seats 28 passengers which 20 of those seats are available for advanced reservation and the other eight will be first come, first seated.

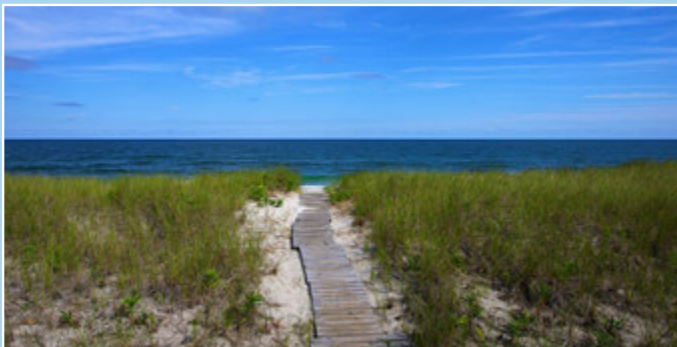
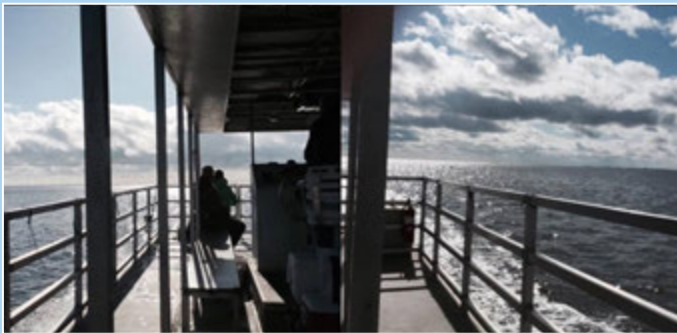
*If you miss the boat for the return trip or in case of inclement weather, your return will be your responsibility.

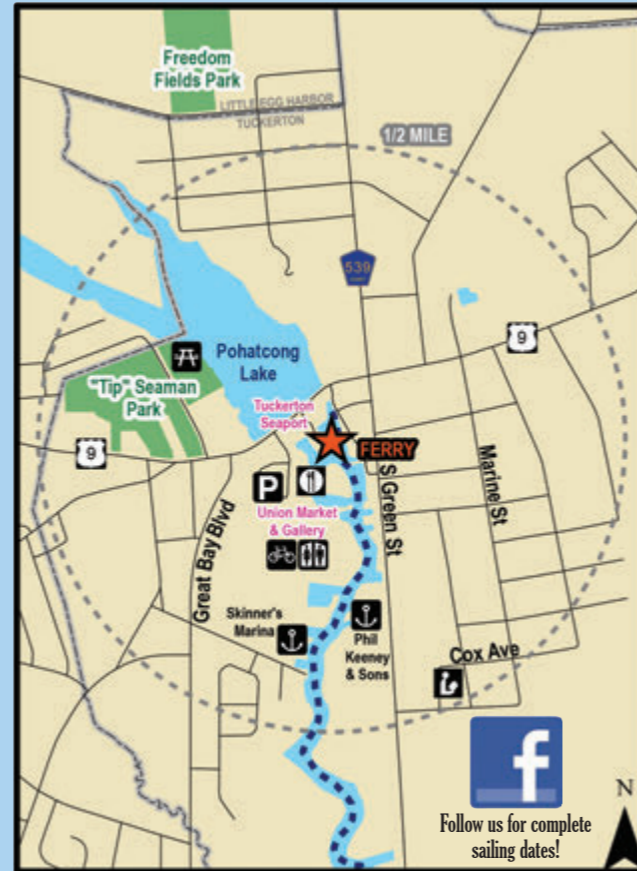

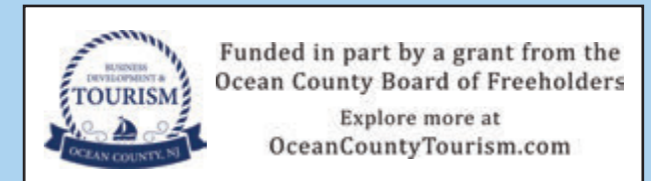
